 4. And — when, be - fore the throne, I stand in Him com - plete,

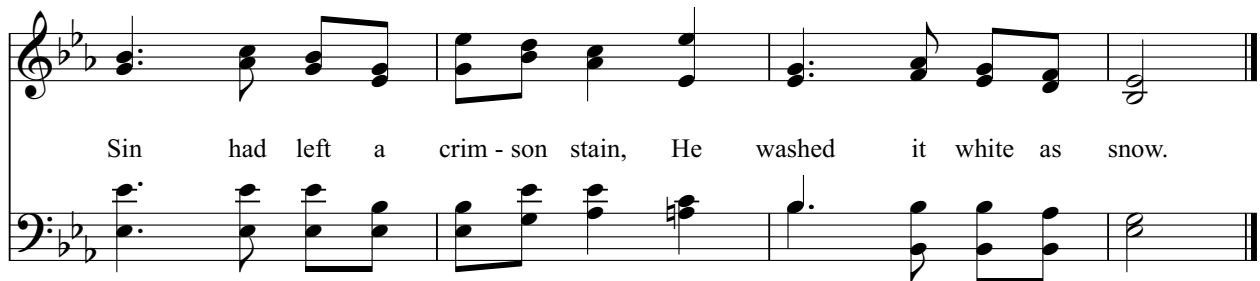


Child of weak - ness, watch and pray, Find in Me thine all in all."
